

The Centenary Memorial Pillar raised in front of the Assembly building.



The foundation stone for the centenary pillar was laid by the then President Shri Ram Nath Kovind on October 21 last year. The President had also planted a sapling of Bodhi tree, which now stands in front of the ceremonial column. The bronze sculpture symbolically depicts the emblem of Bihar - a Bodhi tree with prayer beads dangling from its side branches, flanked by two 'Swastikas

On 22 March 1912, Bihar and Odisha were separated from Bengal and became a separate states. Purna Swaraj was marked in the year 1920. In the year 1936, Odisha was carved out of Bihar and became a separate state. In 1920, the building was constructed. It was completed on 7 February 1921. When it completed 100 years, a program was organized by then Chairman of Legislative Council Shri Tarakant Jha. The first meeting of the Bihar Legislative Council was held in 1913.






