FROM THE DESK OF RESIDENT COMMISSIONER

Bihar Police was conferred the prestigious President's Police Colour Award, while landmarks such as Bapu Tower and the Buddha Samyak Darshan Museum received the CIDC Vishwakarma Award. Achievements in education, innovation, and culture—from JEE Main toppers to global recognition of Bihar Museum—continue to inspire pride.

These developments collectively reflect Bihar's steady progress towards becoming a developed, dynamic, and inclusive state.

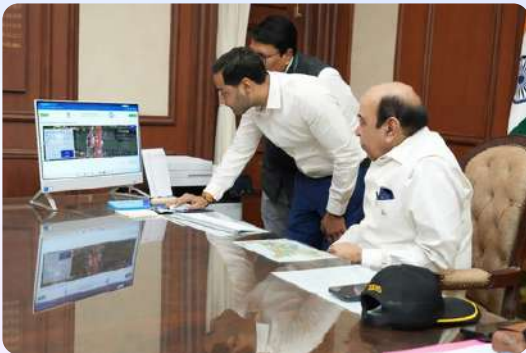
Hon'ble Governor highlights role of Red Cross in healthcare and disaster management



On April 2, 2026, Hon'ble Governor Lt. Gen. Syed Ata Hasnain (Retd.) emphasized critical role of the Indian Red Cross Society in advancing welfare, healthcare, and disaster management while presiding over the Annual General Meeting of its Bihar State Branch at Bihar Lok Bhavan. He underscored the importance of strengthening coordination with National Disaster Management Authority (NDMA), State Disaster Management Authority (SDMA), and National Disaster Response Force (NDRF) to enhance preparedness at the district level. The Hon'ble Governor highlighted the need for timely healthcare services during emergencies and encouraged proactive participation in social health campaigns. He also called upon members to actively contribute to the TB Mukt Bharat Abhiyan, stressing the importance of awareness and collective action toward eliminating tuberculosis in the country.

Hon'ble Governor launches Census-2027 in Bihar

On April 17, 2026, Hon'ble Governor, Lieutenant General (Retd.) Shri Syed Ata Hasnain, formally inaugurated Census-2027 in Bihar by entering his details through the self-enumeration process, marking commencement of the world's largest administrative exercise in the state. On the occasion, he appealed to the people of Bihar to make maximum use of self-enumeration facility and proactively submit their household details online. Government of Bihar will be conducting the first phase of Census-2027, namely the House Listing Operations (HLO), across the state from May 2 to May 31, 2026. Notably, Census-2027 will be India's first fully digital census, featuring comprehensive digital data capture along with a self-enumeration facility for citizens.



Hon'ble Governor graces higher education leaders AI conclave in Patna

On April 21, Hon'ble Governor, Lieutenant General (Retd.) Shri Syed Ata Hasnain, attended "Higher Education Leaders AI Conclave" held at Bapu Tower, Patna, jointly organized by B.D. College, Patna, and MasterSoft ERP, Nagpur. On the occasion, he emphasized that policy, assessment, and technology are the key pillars driving transformation in education. He noted that the National Education Policy, 2020 promotes holistic and multidisciplinary learning, while technology is further strengthening the education system. He also called for collective efforts to make Bihar TB-free, eliminate single-use plastic, and address the growing problem of substance abuse among youth.



Hon'ble Governor-cum-Chancellor graces 9th convocation ceremony of Bihar Agricultural University

On April 24, Hon'ble Governor-cum-Chancellor, Lieutenant General (Retd.) Shri Syed Ata Hasnain, graced the 9th Convocation Ceremony of Bihar Agricultural University, Sabour, Bhagalpur. On the occasion, he talked about the critical importance of sustainable food security in India's journey towards becoming a developed nation by 2047. He emphasized that advancing agricultural research and adopting modern technologies are essential to ensuring the availability of adequate, high-quality food grains for a growing population, while also effectively addressing the challenges posed by climate change.

A new chapter begins: Hon'ble Shri Samrat Choudhary takes charge as Bihar's 24th Chief Minister

On April 15, Hon'ble **Shri Samrat Choudhary** took oath as the **24th Chief Minister of Bihar**, marking an important moment in the state's governance journey. His name was announced earlier the week after due consultations, paving the way for a smooth transition in leadership.

From Deputy Chief Minister to Chief Minister

Hon'ble Shri Samrat Choudhary previously served as the Deputy Chief Minister of Bihar, where he played a key role in administrative coordination and policy implementation. He took over the reins from Hon'ble Shri Nitish Kumar, former Chief Minister.

The oath-taking ceremony

He was administered oath as the new Chief Minister of Bihar at Raj Bhavan, Patna, by Hon'ble Governor Lieutenant General (Retd.) Syed Ata Hasnain. The ceremony was attended by dignitaries, officials, and citizens, reflecting the significance of the occasion.



Building on a strong foundation

The transition follows the tenure of former Chief Minister, Hon'ble Shri Nitish Kumar, under whose leadership Bihar witnessed notable progress in infrastructure, connectivity, and social sectors.

Hon'ble Shri Samrat Choudhary acknowledged these contributions and expressed his commitment to further strengthening the foundation laid over the years, ensuring that Bihar continues its steady path of growth and development.

With continuity in vision and renewed focus, Bihar looks ahead to further progress, driven by effective governance and people-centric initiatives.



Hon'ble CM Shri Samrat Choudhary's first Cabinet clears 22 key decisions

On April 22, Hon'ble CM Shri Samrat Choudhary chaired his first Cabinet meeting, approving 22 key agenda items focused on development, employment, urban expansion, and public safety.



The major highlight is approval for 11 new greenfield satellite townships, aimed at planned urban growth. To ensure structured implementation, restrictions will temporarily apply on land transactions and construction in identified areas.

In a significant step towards women's safety, the Cabinet approved the distribution of 1,500 scooters for women police personnel and 3,200 motorcycles for police forces, with an outlay of ₹66.75 crore.

Boosting religious tourism, the Baba Hariharnath Temple corridor in Sonapur will be developed on the lines of the Kashi Vishwanath Corridor, with an allocation of ₹680 crore. Additionally, 15 acres of land in Tarapur (Munger) has been allocated for tourism development.

The Cabinet approved the Registration Rules 2026, introducing special facilitation for citizens aged 80 and above to ease property registration.

Focusing on skills and employment, 75 ITIs will be upgraded into advanced training centres under the PM-SETU initiative, with an investment of ₹3,615 crore.

Key approvals also include ₹305 crore for a research park at IIT Patna, ₹39.01 crore for an incubation centre (Phase II), ₹172.80 crore for ERSS and police data infrastructure in Rajiv Nagar, and ₹18 crore for advanced fire safety equipment.

Hon'ble CM flags off "Nari Shakti for Viksit Bharat Run"

On April 17, Hon'ble CM Shri Samrat Choudhary participated in "Nari Shakti for Viksit Bharat Run" organised under Nari Shakti Vandan initiative and flagged off participants at JP Ganga Path, Digha Golambar. He emphasized that women today are advancing across sectors and play a vital role in building a stronger and more inclusive society.



Counting for the future: Hon'ble CM Shri Samrat Choudhary launches Census 2027 in Bihar

On April 17, Hon'ble CM Shri Samrat Choudhary formally launched 'Census 2027', described as the world's largest administrative and statistical exercise, from the Chief Minister's Secretariat with a symbolic mouse click. On the occasion, he called upon the people of Bihar to actively and enthusiastically participate in the census process, emphasizing its importance in shaping the state's future.

He highlighted that the census forms the foundation of good governance, playing a crucial role in the formulation of development plans, policies, and welfare programmes in the years ahead. He noted that Census 2027 marks a significant technological advancement, with fully digital data collection and the introduction of a self-enumeration facility available from April 17 to May 1, 2026.



Blending heritage and development: Hon'ble CM lays foundation for Mokama project & inaugurates Parshuram Mela



On April 20, Hon'ble CM Shri Samrat Choudhary laid the foundation stone for a commercial building project at Parshuram Sthan in Mokama (Patna district) and inaugurated the Parshuram Mela through video conferencing.

The project, with an estimated cost of ₹18.11 crore, aims to enhance infrastructure and promote commercial activity in the region while supporting the increasing number of visitors to the site.

Addressing the gathering, Hon'ble CM extended his greetings on the occasion of Bhagwan Parshuram Jayanti and welcomed public representatives, dignitaries, and residents of Mokama who joined the programme virtually. He highlighted that the initiative reflects a balanced approach towards preserving cultural heritage while strengthening local economic opportunities.

Hon'ble CM inaugurates Sitamarhi Mahotsav 2026



On April 25, Hon'ble CM Shri Samrat Choudhary inaugurated Sitamarhi Mahotsav 2026 at Punauradham in Sitamarhi district on the occasion of Janaki Navami. Addressing the gathering, he described his visit to the birthplace of Maa Sita as a moment of pride and spiritual significance. He said that Punauradham is being developed comprehensively as a major cultural and tourist destination. Following a recent review, the timeline for its full development has been advanced from June 2029 to December 31, 2028.

He highlighted plans to connect all sites associated with Maa Janaki to Punauradham, enabling pilgrims and researchers to spend extended time exploring the region. He also noted that an advanced healthcare facility under construction will be named Maa Sita Medical College.

Hon'ble CM Shri Samrat Choudhary informed that the proposed Sitapuram township in Sitamarhi has been approved in the first Cabinet meeting, building upon the vision of former Chief Minister Hon'ble Shri Nitish Kumar.

Connecting with people: Hon'ble CM attends public interaction programme at Tarapur

On April 26, Hon'ble CM Shri Samrat Choudhary attended a public interaction programme held at the Irrigation Division campus in Tarapur, Munger district. Addressing the gathering, he expressed his gratitude for the strong public support and reaffirmed his commitment to maintaining regular engagement with citizens. He emphasized that continuous dialogue with people is essential for effective governance and inclusive development.



Chief Secretary reviews key state initiatives & heat wave preparedness



On April 27, Shri Pratyaya Amrit, Chief Secretary, chaired a comprehensive review meeting to assess progress on key state initiatives. Discussions covered the Gyan Bharatam Mission, Crisis Management Group, and preparations for Census-2027. Special focus was given to heat wave preparedness, with emphasis on mitigation strategies and public safety.

The functioning of the Bihar Weather Service Centre was also reviewed to strengthen forecasting systems. Additionally, progress of major infrastructure projects, including the North Koel Reservoir and Mandai Weir Project, was evaluated. Shri Pratyaya Amrit highlighted the need for coordinated efforts to ensure timely implementation and effective service delivery across sectors.



Chief Secretary reviews PMG projects and PRAGATI schemes



On April 15, a joint high-level review meeting was held under the chairmanship of Shri Pratyaya Amrit, Chief Secretary, to assess key centrally sponsored PMG projects and PRAGATI schemes. The meeting reviewed the latest progress of major initiatives related to infrastructure development, cooperation, and urban sanitation in the state. Emphasis was laid on identifying bottlenecks and accelerating implementation. Shri Pratyaya Amrit directed concerned departments to ensure timely execution and effective coordination to achieve targeted outcomes and strengthen service delivery across sectors.

From Bihta to beyond: Bihar expands its technology and training ecosystem



On April 28, Hon'ble CM Shri Samrat Choudhary inaugurated the newly built Technology Centre at Bihta (Patna) along with four extension centres in Muzaffarpur, Rohtas, Darbhanga, and Munger, developed under the Ministry of Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises, Government of India.

On the occasion, he also launched an entrepreneurship awareness and vendor development programme under the National SC/ST Hub. He visited exhibition stalls set up and reviewed the newly constructed facility, where officials showcased advanced machinery and training infrastructure.

During the programme, beneficiaries of key initiatives – including PM Vishwakarma, PMEGP, SC/ST Hub, and Gram Udyog schemes – were provided with toolkits, certificates, and financial assistance.

Addressing the gathering, Hon'ble CM described the initiative as a significant step towards strengthening Bihar's industrial ecosystem. He noted that the 15-acre Technology Centre in Bihta, along with its extension centres, will play a crucial role in equipping youth with modern technical skills. He highlighted that the centres will offer training focused on product quality, packaging, and effective marketing at national and international levels, enabling youth not only to secure employment but also to generate livelihoods.



NIFTEM in focus: Hon'ble Minister Shri Chirag Paswan visits proposed institute in Vaishali



On April 14, in a significant step towards strengthening Bihar's food processing ecosystem, Hon'ble Union Minister Shri Chirag Paswan visited the Industrial Area, Rajapakar in Vaishali to review the proposed establishment of the National Institute of Food Technology Entrepreneurship and Management (NIFTEM). The visit was led by Shri Kundan Kumar, Secretary, Industries Department-cum-Managing Director, Bihar Industrial Area Development Authority and Infrastructure Development Authority Bihar, who briefed him on the progress of land acquisition. He informed that the process is nearing completion and will be followed by allotment and project initiation. The proposed institute is expected to serve as a premier hub for food technology, entrepreneurship, and innovation, providing a major boost to agro-based industries, skill development, and employment generation in the state.

SIPB drives Bihar's investment momentum with fresh project clearances



On April 16, 66th meeting of State Investment Promotion Board (SIPB) was held under the chairmanship of Shri Mihir Kumar Singh, Development Commissioner-cum-Chairman, State Investment Promotion Council, in the presence of Shri Kundan Kumar, Secretary, Industries Department-cum-Managing Director, Bihar Industrial Area Development Authority and Infrastructure Development Authority Bihar.

During the meeting, 92 projects received Stage-1 clearance involving an investment of ₹2,013.09 crore, while 22 projects were granted financial approval amounting to ₹354.49 crore, marking a significant step in accelerating Bihar's industrial growth.

The meeting also focused on further simplifying approval processes to make them more transparent, efficient, and investor-friendly, while addressing practical challenges faced by investors.

Key proposals included investments from leading companies such as Haldiram Snacks Food Private Limited, Pidilite Industries Limited, HIKEN Healthcare Private Limited, SKPRO Exim Private Limited, Mediversal Simran Medihealth Private Limited, Purvanchal Texknit Mills Private Limited, Shibli Continental Pvt. Ltd., Redcyber Solutions Pvt Ltd, NIF Private Limited, and Leap Agri Logistics (Madhubani) Private Limited, among others.

Bihar accelerates its multi-modal logistics vision



On April 24, a review meeting on Multi-Modal Logistics Park (MMLP) project was held under the chairmanship of Shri Kundan Kumar, Secretary, Industries Department, with participation from officials of the Ministry of Road Transport and Highways (MoRTH) and National Highways Logistics Management Limited (NHLML). During the meeting, the Chair emphasized the need to expedite progress on the ongoing MMLP project, highlighting its strategic importance in strengthening Bihar's logistics and supply chain ecosystem. It was further directed to explore suitable locations for the development of additional MMLPs across the state, with a focused approach on key regions including Purnia, Raxaul, and Bettiah.

From Bihta to IIT Patna: A day of innovation, industry, & skills

On April 23, 2026, in a comprehensive push towards strengthening Bihar's industrial and innovation ecosystem, Shri Kundan Kumar, Secretary, Industries Department, undertook a series of key visits across Bihta and Patna, covering skill development, manufacturing, and startup innovation.

At the Footwear Design & Development Institute (FDDI), Bihta, he reviewed training modules, interacted with students, and appreciated their creativity and product understanding. He highlighted their role in enhancing industry readiness and expanding opportunities for youth. In line with this vision, the Industries Department is set to establish a Leather Footwear Accessories Park, further strengthening Bihar's manufacturing capabilities.



Continuing the visit in Bihta, he visited the facility of Hero Cycles Limited, spread across 7 acres. The unit is generating around 500 employment opportunities and contributing to Bihar's emergence as a manufacturing hub. He engaged with the management to discuss challenges and growth opportunities, reinforcing the focus on efficiency and scale.



At the IIT Patna Incubation Centre, he reviewed Bihar's growing startup ecosystem. Touring advanced facilities such as PCB Development Labs, Testing and Calibration Labs, Mechanical Labs, Clean Rooms, and BioNest Labs, he observed how cutting-edge infrastructure is enabling innovation. Interactions with startup founders showcased progress across sectors including technology, healthcare, electronics, and manufacturing.



PCC clears major industrial allotments, boosting Bihar's growth across key districts

On April 7, the Project Clearance Committee (PCC) of Bihar Industrial Area Development Authority was convened under the chairmanship of Shri Kundan Kumar, Secretary, Industries Department-cum-Managing Director, BIADA & IDA, to review and approve industrial proposals across Bihar.

During the meeting, approvals were granted for the allotment of 63.56 acres of land and ready-built industrial sheds to eligible applicants across key industrial areas in Purnea, Muzaffarpur, Bihta, Begusarai, and Gaya, further strengthening the state's industrial ecosystem.

These projects are expected to bring in investments of about ₹3,000 crore and generate employment opportunities for around 1,500 people, significantly boosting local economic activity.



From plots to progress: BIADA fuels Bihar's industrial expansion across key districts

On April 21, Bihar Industrial Area Development Authority allotted 6.09 acres of land to multiple industrial units, unlocking an estimated investment of ₹94.16 crore and creating around 2,000 employment opportunities, further strengthening Bihar's industrial ecosystem. The approvals were granted during a meeting of the Project Clearance Committee (PCC), where proposals for industrial plots and sheds across various locations were reviewed. The units are spread across industrial areas in Hajipur, Muzaffarpur, Begusarai, Dumaria, Barari, Purnea, and Saharsa, enhancing regional industrial activity. The projects are expected to boost production capacity while generating significant employment for the local workforce.



Bihar Police conferred the President's Police Colour Award

Bihar Police has been conferred the President's Police Colour Award, one of the highest honours bestowed upon a police organisation in India, recognising exceptional service, discipline, and commitment to duty. Also known as the 'Nishan', the award is a symbol of institutional excellence and is granted to police forces demonstrating outstanding performance across multiple parameters.

As part of the honour, Bihar Police will receive a ceremonial flag and a special insignia, which will be worn on the left sleeve of the uniform by all personnel—from constables to the Director General of Police—signifying pride and collective achievement. The evaluation considered key aspects such as overall strength of the force, gender representation, emergency response systems like Dial-112, cyber policing capabilities, training infrastructure, recruitment processes, and digital outreach through online and social media platforms.



Makhana innovation earns Bihar national recognition with Golden Peacock Award



On April 6, in a significant recognition of Bihar's agricultural innovation, Directorate of Horticulture under the state's Agriculture Department has been conferred the Golden Peacock Innovative Product/Service Award 2026 for its work in strengthening the makhana value chain. The award is presented by the Institute of Directors India and was selected by a high-level jury chaired by former Chief Justice of India, Shri Uday Umesh Lalit. The honour recognises Bihar's efforts in enhancing value addition, processing, and market linkages in the makhana sector—one of the state's key agricultural strengths.



Bihar's landmarks earn national acclaim at CIDC Vishwakarma Awards



In a proud moment for the state, two of Bihar's prominent landmarks—Bapu Tower, Patna and the Buddha Samyak Darshan Museum, Vaishali—have been honoured with the 17th CIDC Vishwakarma Award, recognising excellence in construction and infrastructure. The award was conferred by Hon'ble Shri Nitin Gadkari and received by Shri Kumar Ravi, Secretary, Building Construction Department, Government of Bihar, highlighting national recognition for the state's growing focus on high-quality, culturally significant infrastructure.

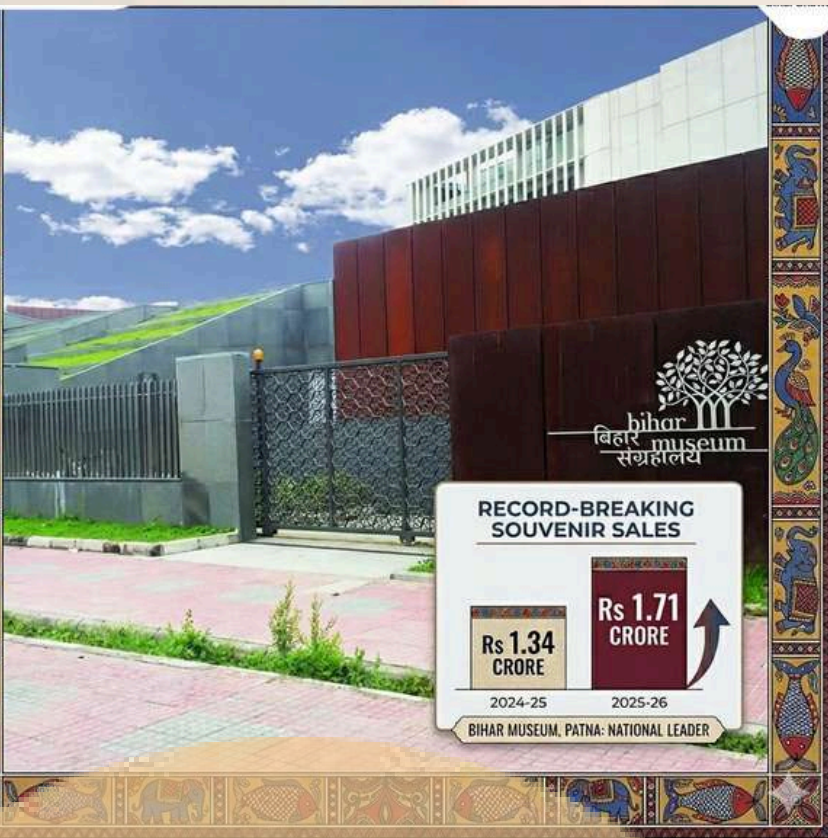
The title marks an important milestone, positioning her to represent Bihar at higher levels of competition and showcase the state's talent on a broader stage.

Global voices arrive in Bihar: International influencers explore Rajgir, Nalanda, and Bodh Gaya
