

#### Bihar gets aviation boost as Hon'ble PM launches Purnea Terminal and mega projects

Purnea, September 15, 2025: Hon'ble Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi visited Bihar and inaugurated the Interim Terminal Building at New Civil Enclave of Purnea Airport, giving a major boost to the state's aviation sector.

On the occasion, His Excellency Governor Shri Arif Mohammed Khan, Hon'ble Chief Minister Shri Nitish Kumar, Hon'ble Union Minister of Civil Aviation Shri Ram Mohan Naidu, and Hon'ble Deputy Chief Ministers Shri Vijay Kumar Sinha and Shri Samrat Choudhary were present.



#### **Key highlights:**

- Inauguration of Interim Terminal Building at Purnea Airport, enhancing Bihar's aviation connectivity.
- Launch of the National Makhana Board in Bihar to boost technology, value addition, exports, and branding—strengthening the global presence of Bihar's Makhana farmers.
- Foundation stone of 3×800 MW Pirpainti Thermal Power Project, Bhagalpur
   Bihar's largest private sector investment worth ₹25,000 crore, designed with low-emission, ultra-super critical technology to ensure energy security.
- Foundation stone of Phase 1 of Kosi-Mechi Intra-State River Link Project
  (₹2,680 crore), aimed at expanding irrigation, enhancing flood control, and
  improving agricultural resilience in northeastern Bihar.
- Inauguration and foundation laying of multiple railway projects, along with the flagging off of new trains, to strengthen Bihar's rail connectivity.







### Over 75 lakh women in Bihar receive ₹10,000 each directly in their bank accounts

In a landmark initiative to empower women across the state, Hon'ble Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi launched Mukhyamantri Mahila Rojgar Yojana via video conferencing on September 26, 2025. Addressing the gathering, he extended his greetings on the auspicious occasion of Navratri and expressed his delight in joining the women of Bihar in their celebrations.

The event was graced by Hon'ble Chief Minister of Bihar, Shri Nitish Kumar, and Hon'ble Union Minister Shri Rajiv Ranjan Singh, among other dignitaries.

Hon'ble PM Shri Narendra Modi highlighted significance of the initiative, noting that 75 lakh women have already joined the scheme. In a historic step towards women's empowerment, ₹10,000 has been directly transferred to the bank accounts of each of these 75 lakh women simultaneously, providing immediate financial support and encouraging economic independence.

### Hon'ble PM hails Bihar's New Ramsar Sites as Milestone in India's Wetlands Conservation Drive



On September 27, 2025, Hon'ble Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi welcomed the addition of two new Ramsar Sites from Bihar—Gokul Jalashay (448 hectares) in Buxar district and Udaipur Jheel (319 hectares) in West Champaran district—calling it a proud moment for India's environmental stewardship.

Patna, September 21, 2025: His Excellency Governor, Shri Arif Mohammad Khan, inaugurated the fifth edition of annual Rajbhasha magazine "Bihar Darshan" of the Regional Passport Office, Patna, at the Durbar Hall of Raj Bhavan. On the occasion, His Excellency emphasized the importance of promoting Hindi as a medium of communication. #### Women Empowerment: Hon'ble CM Launches Mukhyamantri Mahila Rojgar Yojana



Patna, 07 September 2025: Hon'ble Chief Minister Shri Nitish Kumar reaffirmed his Government's commitment to women empowerment by launching application process of Mukhyamantri Mahila Rojgar Yojana from Sankalp, 1 Anne Marg. On the occasion, he also unveiled the online portal for urban applicants and released the scheme's official application form. Hon'ble Chief Minister flagged off 250 awareness vehicles to spread information about the scheme. Over a span of 20 days, these vehicles—supported by JEEViKA cluster-level associations—reached out to communities across the State, sharing details through video screenings at identified locations.

#### Hon'ble CM Flags Off 80 Pink Buses for Women, Launches E-Ticketing Across 1,065 Buses

**Patna, 08 September 2025:** Hon'ble Chief Minister Shri Nitish Kumar took a major step towards safe and convenient transport for women by flagging off 80 Pink Buses under the second phase of the scheme from 1 Anne Marg. He also inaugurated the e-ticketing facility across all 1,065 buses of Bihar State Road Transport Corporation (BSRTC), modernising the State's public transport system.



### All you need to know about Bihar Industrial Investment Promotion Package (BIIPP) 2025

Patna, 11 September 2025: Government of Bihar officially launched Bihar Industrial Investment Promotion Package (BIIPP) 2025, a landmark policy aimed at accelerating industrial growth, attracting investment, and generating employment across the state. The policy, approved by the cabinet in August 2025, was highlighted by a special address from Hon'ble Union Minister of Commerce and Industry Shri Piyush Goyal, who emphasized its potential to create over one crore new jobs and promote inclusive growth.



#### **Key Provisions of BIIPP 2025**

The BIPP 2025, an upgraded version of the 2016 package, offers enhanced incentives tailored for various types of investors:

#### Land Allocation:

- Investments above ₹100 crore generating at least 1,000 direct jobs will receive up to 10 acres of land free of cost.
- Investments exceeding ₹1,000 crore can get up to 25 acres.
- Land is also offered at discounted rates for other investors.

#### · Financial Incentives:

- Capital Subsidy: Up to 30% of the project cost for capital-intensive industries.
- SGST Reimbursement: Up to 300% of project cost over 14 years for high sales and GSToutflow companies.
- Interest Subvention: Combined with SGST reimbursement to reduce borrowing costs for MSMEs.

#### Other Benefits:

- Enhanced Export Incentives: Doubled from ₹20 lakh to ₹40 lakh annually for 14 years.
- Employment-Linked Support: Up to ₹5,000 per month for local hires in sectors such as textiles and leather.
- R&D Assistance: Reimbursement for patent filing and quality certification expenses.
- Support for Startups: Covers businesses with investments as low as ₹50 lakh.

The BIIPP 2025 is expected to significantly boost industrial development, strengthen the state's investment climate, and create sustainable employment opportunities across Bihar.

#### A dialogue with investors in Delhi under BIIPP 2025

New Delhi, September 24: Department of Industries, Government of Bihar, organized an investor dialogue meet in Delhi under the newly launched Bihar Industrial Investment Promotion Package (BIIPP)–2025. The programme was held at Hotel Lalit, New Delhi, following the package's launch in Patna earlier this month. Industry Minister Shri Nitish Mishra attended the session as Chief Guest. Shri Mihir Kumar Singh, Additional Chief Secretary, Shri B. Kartikeya Dhanji, Secretary, Shri Kundan Kumar, MD, BIADA along with senior industry leaders and officials, also participated.













#### WFI 2025: Bihar Showcases Food Processing Opportunities

New Delhi, September 26: A special session on "Opportunities in Bihar's Food Sector" was held at Bharat Mandapam, New Delhi. The event highlighted Bihar's growing potential in the food processing sector, investment opportunities, and government support to promote agro-based industries.

**Mumbai, September 18–19:** Bihar took center stage at the ICC Global Business Summit 2025, Asia's foremost gathering of top business and government leaders hosted by the Indian Chamber of Commerce.





On Day 1, Shri Kundan Kumar, Managing Director, BIADA & IDA Bihar, presented the vision of Hon'ble Chief Minister Shri Nitish Kumar and Government of Bihar. He outlined the state's investor- and industry-friendly framework, policy reforms, and ease-of-doing-business measures that are fueling growth, attracting investments, and creating jobs.



On Day 2, Shri Kumar held B2G meetings with leading AI and IT companies, as well as a business delegation from Cyprus, exploring collaboration opportunities in Bihar. He also visited SEEPZ (Special Economic Zone) and MIDC offices in Mumbai.

#### Patna Metro on Track as Final Trial Run Concludes Successfully



**Patna, September 29:** Patna Metro project achieved a major milestone with a successful completion of its final trial run. The trial examined all key technical aspects, including signaling systems, track strength, train speed, and braking efficiency. With all earlier shortcomings resolved, the Metro has now been deemed safe and ready for operations, pending the formal issuance of a safety certificate.

The Patna Metro trains will run at a speed of up to 40 kmph, with three coaches accommodating around 945 passengers. Safety features include 360-degree cameras in each coach and emergency contact systems. Fares have been set at a minimum of ₹15, with ₹30 for a full stretch between New ISBT and Bhutnath Road.

Adding to its appeal, the Metro coaches are decorated with Madhubani art, showcasing Bihar's heritage with motifs of Golghar, Mahavir Mandir, Bodhi Tree, Nalanda ruins, and more. The official inauguration date will be announced after the safety certification is issued.

#### Mumbai-Style Open Double-Decker Bus Service in Patna

Patna, September 2: Bihar's capital now offers tourists a unique experience with the launch of a Mumbai-style open double-decker bus service along JP Ganga Path. The service was inaugurated by Tourism Minister Shri Raju Singh, running on a 15-km route from Digha Rotary to Kangan Ghat. The buses operate from 5 PM to 10 PM, offering passengers spectacular views of the Ganga and city landmarks, including Golambar, Sabhyata Dwar, Darbhanga House, Gandhi Ghat, Mahatma Gandhi Setu, Chitragupt Mandir, and Kangan Ghat. Each bus has 40 seats — 20 AC seats on the lower deck and 20 on the upper deck. Facilities include a toilet, refrigerator, and a guide providing information on the route and attractions. Fares are set at ₹100 per person for a round trip and ₹50 for a one-way trip.



#### Bihar Gets Its First Coca-Cola Plant in Buxar



**Buxar, September 23:** Bihar's industrial landscape received a major boost with the inauguration of the state's first Coca-Cola plant in Buxar. The event was attended by local representatives, industry leaders, and residents. The state-of-the-art facility is expected to generate hundreds of direct and indirect jobs and provide additional income opportunities to local farmers through the supply of fruits and other raw materials. Bihar Industrial Area Development Authority (BIADA) and the state government played a key role by facilitating land, infrastructure, and incentives under the "Make in Bihar" initiative. The plant is expected to boost local beverage production, increase revenue, and support Bihar's growing industrial ecosystem.

#### Bihar Records Largest Decline in Urban Poverty



Bihar has achieved a significant milestone in poverty reduction over the past decade. According to a recent research paper by the RBI's Economic and Policy Research Department, Bihar recorded the largest decline in urban poverty among India's major states between 2011-12 and 2022-23. The study updated the Rangarajan poverty line using the government's Household Consumption Expenditure Survey (HCES) data. The results show that the percentage of Bihar's urban population living below the poverty line fell from 50.8% in 2011-12 to 9.1% in 2022-23. This marks the steepest drop in urban poverty recorded across the country. The findings highlight the impact of economic growth, social welfare programs, and policy interventions in improving living standards in Bihar.

#### ₹2.5 Crore Award to Asia Cup 2025 Winning Indian Hockey Team

Patna, 19 September 2025: Hon'ble Chief Minister Shri Nitish Kumar felicitated the victorious Indian men's hockey team of Hero Asia Cup 2025 at an event held at 'Samvad', Chief Minister's Secretariat, Patna. Each player, the head coach, and assistant coaches were awarded ₹10 lakh along with a certificate of appreciation, while the support staff received ₹5 lakh each.



During the ceremony, Hon'ble Chief Minister presented a symbolic cheque of ₹2.5 crore to Indian team captain Shri Harmanpreet Singh on behalf of all players and support staff. He congratulated the entire team and coaching staff for their stellar performance and wished them continued success in the future. The event concluded with a group photograph of the Chief Minister with the

players and staff.

The Hero Asia Cup 2025 for men was held at the Hockey Stadium of Rajgir Sports Complex – State Sports Academy & Bihar Sports University, Rajgir, from 29 August to 7 September, featuring eight major Asian teams: China, Japan, South Korea, Malaysia, Kazakhstan, Chinese Taipei, Bangladesh, and India. The Indian team triumphed over South Korea in the final.





Earlier, Hon'ble Chief Minister Shri Nitish Kumar had unveiled the logo and mascot of the tournament on 17 August 2025 in Patna and inaugurated the event in Rajgir on 29 August 2025.

This victory came after Indian women's hockey team was similarly awarded by Hon'ble CM for their Asia Cup win at Rajgir, highlighting Bihar's commitment to promoting hockey and sporting excellence.

### Science Exhibition Bus and New Initiatives Launched at Taramandal, Patna

Patna, 20 September 2025: A Science Exhibition Bus was inaugurated at Taramandal, Patna under a program organized by the Department of Science, Technology and Technical Education. The bus traveled across Bihar to create awareness among students about science and related subjects. During the program, several new initiatives of the Department were launched. These included the inauguration of a Virtual Reality Theater at Taramandal, Patna, and the launch of an M.Tech level Geoinformatics course at the Astro Park and Bihar Remote Sensing Application



The program also witnessed the signing of a Memorandum of Understanding between the Bihar Council on Science and Technology and the National Science Museum Council for the construction of an observatory dome with telescopes at Taramandal, Patna. This project aimed to bring science closer to the public, providing students and science enthusiasts with interactive, engaging, and practical experiences.

Additionally, Hon'ble Chief Minister Shri Nitish Kumar attended the 2nd convocation of Bihar Engineering University, Patna, and conferred degrees to the graduating students.

#### 21-acre Science City in Bihar with 4D theatre launched



Patna, 21 September 2025: Hon'ble Chief Minister Shri Nitish Kumar inaugurated newly constructed Dr. A.P.J. Abdul Kalam Science City on a 21-acre site in Rajendra Nagar, Patna. The Science City is designed to be an attractive and unique center for students and the public to explore and understand science and technology. The Science City features five science-themed galleries, 269 interactive science exhibits, an auditorium, a 4D theater, and dormitory facilities for students and teachers, making it a major hub for science education and engagement in the state.

### Three Teachers from Bihar Receive National Teacher's Award 2025

New Delhi, September 6: Her Excellency President of India, Smt Droupadi Murmu conferred National Teacher's Award 2025 to three teachers from Bihar, an honour to be officially presented on Teachers' Day in New Delhi.

The award, given annually to recognise excellence and innovation in education, will be conferred on 45 teachers across India this year. From Bihar, the awardees are:



- Kumari Nidhi (Kishanganj) Head teacher recognised for leadership and classroom reforms
- Dilip Kumar (Supaul) Honoured for dedication to education and focus on student development
- Dr Pramod Kumar (Nalanda) Commended for contributions to pedagogy and raising teaching standards

#### Bihar Emerges as 4th Largest Honey Producer in India



Bihar has emerged as the country's fourth-largest honey producer with an annual output of 18,030 metric tonnes in 2023–24. Over the past two decades, honey production in the state has grown rapidly, generating thousands of jobs and improving rural livelihoods. Favorable climate, rich biodiversity, and government incentives have

fueled this growth. Under various schemes, beekeepers receive 75% subsidy (up to 90% for SC/ST farmers) on bee boxes, hives, and extraction equipment, along with training in honey production and management. Bihar's honey varieties are gaining national recognition — lychee honey from Muzaffarpur, Vaishali, and Samastipur is in high demand for its unique taste, while mustard honey from Nalanda and Patna, and sesame honey from Aurangabad and Rohtas add to the state's diverse honey portfolio. The state government also distributes 20,000 to 1 lakh bee boxes annually under its pollination promotion programme, further supporting farmers and boosting production.

#### Bihar's Festive Flavors: Thekua and More for Diwali and Chhath



As the festive season approaches, Bihar prepares to celebrate Diwali and Chhath Pooja with traditional sweets and snacks that reflect the state's rich culinary heritage. Among these, thekua stands out as an iconic treat. Made from whole wheat flour, jaggery or sugar, and ghee, thekua is deep-fried to golden perfection, often shaped into intricate patterns, serving both as an offering to deities and a beloved snack for families.

Other festive favorites include laddoos, khaja, tilkut, and malpua, each with unique flavors and regional variations. Mustard seeds, sesame, jaggery, and ghee give these sweets their characteristic taste. Savory items like chakli, nimki, and mathri complement the sweet offerings, adding variety to the festive table.

#### Navratri celebrations @ Netherlands

Members of Bihar Foundation Netherlands recently performed the traditional Jhijhiya folk song, celebrating the spirit of Navratri. Jhijhiya is a folk ritual from Bihar in which women balance lamp-pots on their heads to invoke Maa Durga and ward off evil spirits.
