



# BIHAR gets Asia's widest six-lane Ganga Bridge on NH-31 at Simaria



Hon'ble Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi visited Bihar on August 22, 2025, and inaugurated as well as laid the foundation stone for development **projects worth over ₹13,000 crore**, covering Gaya, Patna, Muzaffarpur, Munger, Begusarai, and other districts. Hon'ble Chief Minister Shri Nitish Kumar joined him during the historic occasion.

#### **KEY HIGHLIGHTS:**

- Infrastructure & Connectivity Inauguration of the 8.15-km Aunta–Simaria six-lane Ganga bridge on NH-31 (₹1,870 crore), connecting Mokama and Begusarai, along with the four-lane Bakhtiyarpur–Mokama section (₹1,900 crore). Hon'ble PM also flagged off the Amrit Bharat Express (Gaya–Delhi) and the Buddhist Circuit Train (Vaishali–Koderma), enhancing passenger convenience and religious tourism.
- Energy Security Dedication of the 660 MW Buxar Thermal Power Plant (₹6,880 crore), a major step in strengthening Bihar's power supply.
- **Healthcare** Inauguration of the Homi Bhabha Cancer Hospital and Research Centre at Muzaffarpur, equipped with advanced oncology facilities, ICU wards, and modern laboratories, ensuring affordable cancer care.
- **Urban Development & Clean Ganga** Launch of a sewerage treatment plant and network in Munger (₹520 crore) under the Namami Gange Programme, and foundation laying for urban water supply and sewerage projects worth ₹1,260 crore across Aurangabad, Jehanabad, Lakhisarai, Bodh Gaya, and Jamui.
- **Housing for All** Under Pradhan Mantri Awas Yojana (PMAY), Hon'ble PM handed over keys to more than 16,000 beneficiary families, marking their Grih Prayesh.





Rashtrapati Bhavan's Independence Day Invite

Bihar's traditional sikki craft has received national recognition by featuring in Rashtrapati Bhavan's 'At Home' Independence Day invites this year. Each invite kit included a sikki grass box from Bihar enclosing a bamboo frame with the official invite, along with four folk paintings representing the eastern region – Madhubani (Bihar), Pattachitra (Bengal), Talapatra Chitra (Odisha), and Paitkar (Jharkhand). The ensemble was complemented by a hand-painted tag and a block-printed tussar silk stole.

Hon'ble CM expressed heartfelt gratitude to Hon'ble Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi for ensuring enhanced connectivity through rail and road projects, including the launch of a new train service from Sitamarhi to Delhi. He described the construction of this divine temple as a matter of immense pride not only for Bihar but for the entire nation.



## Hon'ble CM ties Rakhi to trees and leads Tree Protection Day plantation drive

August 9, 2025 – On the occasion of Raksha Bandhan and Bihar Tree Protection Day, Hon'ble Chief Minister Shri Nitish Kumar tied Rakhi to a tree and planted a sapling at Rajdhani Vatika, Patna. Notably, the CM had initiated the observance of Bihar Tree Protection Day on August 13, 2012, to promote awareness on environmental conservation and mass plantation. He reiterated that tree plantation and protection are vital to counter the impacts of climate change.

Under the Jal-Jeevan-Hariyali mission and other initiatives, the State Government is undertaking extensive plantation drives and promoting eco-tourism, fostering public awareness on environment protection and wildlife conservation.



# 71 new police vehicles to strengthen traffic enforcement in Bihar



August 2, 2025 - Hon'ble Chief Minister Shri Nitish Kumar inaugurated 71 newly procured dedicated to vehicles enforcement across the state. The vehicles, assigned to Deputy Superintendents of Police (Traffic) and traffic police stations, were flagged off from the Chief Minister's official residence at 1 Anne Marg. Hon'ble CM highlighted that the new vehicles will enhance traffic monitoring, accident response, and enforcement of road safety regulations across national and highways as well as urban centres. "These only improve vehicles will not traffic regulation but will also support effective implementation of traffic rules and help prevent accidents," he said.



# Bihar strengthens social security: ₹1,247 crore reaches over 1.12 Crore pensioners

August 10, 2025 – Hon'ble Chief Minister Shri Nitish Kumar transferred ₹1,247.34 crore directly to the bank accounts of over 1.12 crore beneficiaries under the Social Security Pension Scheme at a programme held at Sankalp, 1 Anne Marg. The July pension of ₹1,100 per beneficiary for senior citizens, differently-abled persons, and widows was credited via DBT with a single click. Hon'ble CM highlighted that under the scheme, monthly pensions have been increased from ₹400 to ₹1,100 per beneficiary since June 2025, ensuring timely financial support. He emphasized that every eligible pensioner must receive their entitlement without delay, and new beneficiaries are being added continuously. Over the past month, approximately 1 lakh new pensioners were included, further expanding the scheme's reach and strengthening social welfare across the state.

# Bihar Appoints 5,353 Clerks and Attendants in Schools under Compassionate Scheme

**August 19, 2025** – A total of 5,353 candidates have been appointed as school clerks (4,835) and school attendants (518) in secondary and higher secondary schools across Bihar under the compassionate recruitment scheme. Appointment letters were handed over at a ceremony held at the Chief Minister's Secretariat 'Samvad', with selected candidates Mani Kumari, Amit Gaurav, Divya Raj, Kiran Kumari Gupta, and Tuba Ashraf receiving their letters symbolically. The initiative provides improved pay and service conditions for eligible dependents of deceased school staff.

The scheme, operational since 2006 for dependents of deceased teaching and non-teaching staff, was expanded in 2020–2024 to include clerks and attendants at prescribed pay levels. For Patna district, 212 clerks and 28 attendants were appointed. The event was attended by senior officials including the Education Minister Shri Sunil Kumar, Deputy Chief Ministers Shri Samrat Chaudhary and Shri Vijay Kumar Sinha, and other dignitaries.

# Hon'ble CM Shri Nitish Kumar Inaugurates Bihar Museum Biennale 2025

August 7, 2025 – Hon'ble Chief Minister Shri Nitish Kumar remotely unveiled the emblem of Bihar Museum Biennale 2025 and inaugurated temporary exhibitions presented by various countries. The Biennale showcases diverse themes including festivals and performances, symbolism and celebration, initiation ceremonies, excavations in Chirand, aesthetics, and health and wellness. Hon'ble CM also visited exhibitions highlighting the culture, history, and natural beauty of countries such as Thailand, Indonesia, Zambia, Mexico, Korea, Sri Lanka, Ethiopia, and Argentina.

# HON'BLE DEPUTY CM SHRI SAMRAT CHOUDHARY VISITS DELHI FOR KEY MEETINGS ON STATE DEVELOPMENT

Hon'ble Dy CM also met Hon'ble Union Petroleum & Natural Gas Minister Shri Hardeep Singh Puri to discuss increasing the number of ethanol plants in Bihar and providing an additional 10 lakh free LPG connections under Ujjwala Yojana. August 23, 2025 – Hon'ble Chief Minister Shri Nitish Kumar visited Vashi Medicare Pvt. Ltd. in the Phulhara Industrial Area under BIADA to inspect surgical gloves production and the company's testing facilities. The unit, spread over 24,156 sq. ft., employs 300–350 people, with priority given to women, supporting economic empowerment and local development. Its products are exported across India, Kenya, and Nepal, highlighting Bihar's growing industrial footprint.

Hon'ble CM also reviewed operations at Vashi Air Gases Pvt. Ltd. and a high-tech commercial unit producing school bags and backpacks. The visit emphasized skill development and employment generation, with women employees playing a key role in boosting production and contributing to economic growth. The inspection was attended by senior officials including Principal Secretary Shri Deepak Kumar, Additional Chief Secretary Shri Singh, Patna Kumar Commissioner Dr. Chandra Shekhar Singh, and other dignitaries.



# "BIHAR HAI TAIYAR — A JOURNEY OF TRANSFORMATION (2005—2025)"



## **BIADA AMNESTY POLICY 2025:**

It's time to revive closed industries in Bihar



Bihar Industrial Area Development Authority (BIADA) launched new Amnesty Policy to help closed or disputed industrial units restart work. The scheme is open till December 31, 2025.

Under this policy, industries whose land was cancelled due to disputes, non-operation or no response to notices can apply again by giving an affidavit, charges, and a bank guarantee.

The aim is to reduce long court cases, bring unused land back into use, boost production, create jobs, and support Bihar's industrial growth.



#### **Key Benefits of the Policy:**

- This is a one-time opportunity, which can be availed till 31st December 2025.
- The policy will apply to all allottees who voluntarily wish to avail its benefits.
- All beneficiaries will get the opportunity to establish/revive industries like new entrepreneurs.
- Beneficiaries may either operate the enterprise themselves, or
- They can change/transfer the product.


#### **Main Provisions:**

- Eligibility: All defaulting units (except those cases where land has already been allotted to third parties).
- Application Process: Units will apply online/offline with an affidavit, required documents, and prescribed fees.
- BIADA will grant in-principle approval within 3 working days
- Thereafter, the applicant must withdraw pending court cases and deposit BIADA's dues.
- Once all formalities are completed, BIADA will issue final approval within 7 working days.

#### Fees & Charges

Administrative Fee:

The unit will have to pay **1% of the plot rate** as an administrative fee.

Its red cap signifies energy, while the magician-like hat honors hockey wizard Major Dhyan Chand, after whom it is named. The design also draws inspiration from Bihar's Valmiki Tiger Reserve, symbolizing pride, discipline, and determination. With a hockey stick in hand and eyes fixed on the goal, Chand reflects dedication, sportsmanship, and the true spirit of the game. The emblem on its chest salutes Major Dhyan Chand's unmatched contribution to Indian hockey.





## About Rajgir Sports Complex

Rajgir's State Sports Academy-cum-Bihar Sports University, developed with world-class facilities, is the venue for the Asia Rugby U-20 Championship. The complex has already hosted several events under the Khelo India Youth Games 2025, positioning Bihar as a rising hub of sports excellence.

### **About the Teams**

Nine countries are participating in the championship: India, China, UAE, Hong Kong, Kazakhstan, Uzbekistan, Sri Lanka, Malaysia, and Nepal. All teams are staying in Rajgir, fostering cultural exchange and sporting camaraderie.

## From Sikki to Stardom

Two Village Daughters Show the World Their Talent



This is the inspiring story of Samba and Sangeeta, two ordinary women from Bettiah, Bihar, who turned their traditional craft into their greatest strength. Born in the soil of West Champaran, they once lived a simple life in the lanes of Barihani Tola and Champanagar. Their resource was the magic of Sikki grass, but their dreams were big-to empower every woman in their village.

#### When Skill Became a Mission

The two women revived the traditional Sikki craft—used to make casserole baskets, tea coasters, bottle covers, and even bangles—and gave it a new identity. What was once limited to village homes is now in demand across India. At Delhi Haat, Sangeeta showcased their products for 11 days and proved that talent only needs a stage; recognition follows on its own.

# From Villagers to National Trainers

Their hard work was recognized by the Patna Industries Department, which selected them as national and international trainers. Today, they train dozens of women in Gaunaha and nearby villages for 60 days, helping every household woman become self-reliant.

#### Bihar's Craft Goes Nationwide

Products made and Sambá Sangeeta cities like now reach Bhagalpur, Dehradun, Rishikesh, and several towns in Jharkhand. A craft that once belonged only to village soil is now admired across country.

## **Dehati to Disruptor:**

### **How a Young Bihari Turned Soil** into a ₹2.5 Cr Revolution

They called him "Dehati", but Prince Shukla, a 24-year-old B.Sc. Agriculture graduate from Bihar, is now transforming the future of Indian farming—one village at a time.

Prince once dreamt of a global academic journey. He had landed a job in Bengaluru and was preparing for a prestigious scholarship to Switzerland. But when the pandemic struck, everything came to a halt. His plans collapsed, returned home-disappointed, directionless, and unsure of what came next



What he found back in his village changed his life forever.

Local farmers were struggling—trapped in outdated techniques, poor-quality seeds, and lack of access to modern tools. Most were caught in a cycle of **low yield and deepening** poverty.

That's when Prince made a bold move. With just ₹1 lakh borrowed from his father, he launched AGRATE—an agri-tech startup focused on empowering small and marginal farmers. His mission? To make highquality seeds, drip irrigation systems, and eco-friendly fertilisers accessible and affordable. But he didn't stop there.

Prince began training farmers in multi-cropping, sustainable that not only improved soil health but Bihar.

practices-techniques doubled their income. He even bridged linguistic barriers to help farmers in Odisha grow makhana, a crop traditionally associated with Of course, the journey wasn't easy. Prince was mocked, doubted, and dismissed—labeled a 'Dehati" for leaving a corporate path behind. But with patience, persistence, and purpose, he turned that label into a badge of honour.

The soil I returned to isn't just growing crops—it's growing change," says Prince.

Today, from a small village in Bihar, Prince Shukla is redefining Indian agriculture—proving that innovation doesn't need a city skyline. It only needs a rooted heart and a rising vision.


